Betsy Wolfe was most recently seen in the hit musical & Juliet as Anne Hathaway where her performance was nominated for the 2023 Tony Award for Best Featured Actress in a Musical. Previously, Wolfe starred as Jenna Hunterson, the title role in the Tony nominated musical *Waitress*, Cordelia in the Broadway revival of *Falsettos*, and her critically acclaimed performance as Cathy in the

off-Broadway revival of *The Last Five Years*. She starred in the holiday film *Estella Scrooge:* A *Christmas Carol With A Twist*, the indie film *First One In*, and had a guest starring role on the CBS series *Instinct*. Other Broadway credits include Ellen in Bullets Over Broadway, Rosa Bud in *The Mystery of Edwin Drood*, *110 in the Shade*, and *Everyday Rapture*. Wolfe made her Metropolitan Opera debut in *Die Fledermaus*.

She has been a guest artist for over 60 symphony, pops, and philharmonic orchestras around the world including the New York Philharmonic, Chicago Symphony Orchestra, The New York Pops and the BBC Orchestra.

Susan V. Booth (Goodman Theatre Walter Artistic Director) joined Goodman Theatre in the fall of 2022, having previously served as Artistic Director of Atlanta's Tony Award-winning Alliance Theatre, premiering new work that went on to national, international, and commercial life. She has directed at the Goodman. Hartford Stage, Ford's Theatre, La Jolla Playhouse,



NICK JONAS

Nick Jonas is a singer, songwriter, actor, and producer, and began his career at age eight in an off-Broadway production of A Christmas Carol (2000). He gained recognition on Broadway, including Annie Get Your Gun (2001), Beauty and the Beast (2002), and Les Misérables (2003), where he portrayed Gavroche. He starred as Kurt von Trapp in The Sound of Music (2003), and later as Marius Pontmercy in the 25th Anniversary production of Les Misérables in London's West End (2010). Nick earned acclaim for his portrayal of Link Larkin in Hairspray (2011) at Hollywood Bowl. In 2012, he played J. Pierrepont Finch in How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying on Broadway, receiving rave reviews. As part of Jonas Brothers, Nick achieved global fame with chart-topping hits. His solo work includes smash hits like "Jealous" and "Chains." Nick received the prestigious Hal David Starlight Award at Songwriters Hall Of Fame, which recognizes songwriters who have made significant impact in the music industry. Jonas Brothers returned to Broadway in 2023 with a five-night residency at Marquis Theater, performing an album each night. Nick has also starred in films like Jumanji, The Good Half, upcoming film Power Ballad and more. Nick will soon portray Frankie Valli in the filmed production of Jersey Boys.


generation-skipping transfer tax, asset protection, and philanthropic planning.

UK), Soft (New York Times Critic's Pick, MCC), On Sugarland (New York Theatre Workshop), Our Dear Dead Drug Lord (WP Theater, New York Times Critic's Pick), What to Send Up When it Goes Down (New York Times Critic's Pick), The Amen Corner (Shakespeare Theatre DC), An Iliad (Long Wharf), Canyon (LA Times Critic's Choice, IAMA), Jump (National New Play Network Rolling World Premier, PlayMakers Rep). Original works include: Semblance (NYTW), Definition (Bushwick Starr), and Macbeth in Stride, for which she won an Elliot Norton Award for Best Musical Performance (American Repertory Theatre, Under the Radar Festival at The Public Theatre). Her four-part cycle, Reach For It, deconstructing Shakespeare's women is

currently in development with American Repertory Theater (Boston, MA) and the Royal Shakespeare Company (UK). Her musical discipline is rooted in electro-rock, industrial, and soul. Annaleigh Ashford is a Tony Award-winning, Emmy and Grammy-nominated actor, singer, and writer who is currently starring in the Paramount+ Original Series, *Happy Face*. Ashford most recently earned the 2023 Drama League Award for Distinguished Performance, a Tony Award nomination, and a Drama Desk Award for her portrayal of Mrs. Lovett in the Broadway revival of

Sweeney Todd: The Demon Barber of Fleet Street. Her NY stage credits include Sunday in the Park with George (opposite Jake Gyllenhaal), You Can't Take It With You (Tony Award, Drama Desk Award, Outer Critics Circle Award), Sylvia, Kinky Boots (Clarence Derwent Award; Tony, Drama Desk, and Outer Critics Circle nominations), Wicked, Hair, Legally Blonde the Musical, and All In. Off-Broadway, she appeared in Sunday in the Park with George (Encores!), Midsummer Night's Dream (The Public Theater's Shakespeare in the Park), Rent (New World Stages), and Dogfight (Second Stage). On screen, Ashford's credits include Happy Face, Dust, Welcome to Chippendales, American Crime Story: Impeachment, B Positive, Unbelievable, Masters of Sex, Law & Order: SVU, Second Act, The Rocky Horror Picture Show, and Disney's Frozen. She holds an honorary doctorate from Marymount Manhattan College, where she also graduated.



LISA STEPHEN FRIDAY

Lisa Stephen Friday (she, her, hers) is a singer, musician, actor, and theater maker based in New York City. Lisa is

a New York Voices commissioned artist with Joe's Pub at the Public Theater and a 2025 recipient of New York State Council on The Arts Artist Grant. Lisa's work includes her one-woman show *TRANS AM The Musical, DOLL/GIRL* (about the life and work of Greer Lankton), and her latest

project: A Musical for Henrietta. In 2022, TRANS AM premiered at the Keegan Theater in Washington DC and was featured in the Hangar Theater's summer season. TRANS AM made its New York City debut at Joe's Pub in March. In 2023, DOLL/GIRL had its first public presentation at Judson Memorial Church, where Lisa and co-creator Joseph Ritsch were artists in residence. From 2000-2006, Lisa fronted and wrote songs for the band Lisa Jackson and Girl Friday and shared the stage with The Psychedelic Furs, The Motels, and Pat Benatar. In Fall 2022, Lisa returned to acting when she joined the cast of Robert O'Hara's Barbecue at The Human Race Theater in the role of Adlene, and made her Off-Broadway debut in Pipeline Theatre Company's World Premiere of House of Telescopes.

Trailblazer Award



CONGRESSWOMAN SARAH NGBRIDE

Congresswoman Sarah McBride proudly represents the greatest state in the nation, and our country's First State, Delaware, as its sole member of Congress.

Sarah grew up in Wilmington and has been serving our state for decades as a public servant and advocate. From 2020-2025, Congresswoman McBride served as State Senator for the First State Senate District. She worked for former Governor Jack Markell and the late Attorney General Beau Biden, and served as the national spokesperson for the Human Rights Campaign, the nation's largest LGBTQ equal rights organization.

Prior to her service in the State Senate, McBride led the successful effort to pass a landmark non-discrimination law in Delaware. For her work and advocacy, former Gov. Markell awarded McBride the Order of the First State, making her one of the youngest Delawareans granted the state's highest civilian honor.

Sarah married her late husband Andrew Cray in 2014 and is the proud aunt of seven. She is a graduate of Cab Calloway School of the Arts and American University. McBride has taught public policy at the University of Delaware and

is the author of the 2018 memoir, "Tomorrow Will Be Different," which includes a foreword from President Joe Biden.

DUNE THORNE

Dune Thorne is a Partner at Brown Advisory an investment advisory firm managing over \$170B in assets where she serves on the Executive Committee and as the Chief Strategy Officer. Her work is focused on multi-generational planning for global families and family offices with a focus on engaging women and sustainable and impact investing.


In 2010 she founded Invest in Girls, a non-profit focused on financial literacy for under-represented high-school girls that works with over 6,000 girls across the country and is continuing to grow and expand through its combination with The Council for Economic Education.

Dune has been honored with numerous awards, including the Top 50 Women Leaders of Massachusetts, EV Kids Youth Champion Award, World Economic Forum' Young Global Leader, Advisor One's Top 50 Women in Wealth, and Boston Business Journal's Emerging Leader. A frequent speaker, radio and television interviewee, Dune authored her own TEDx talk, "Jump to the New S Curve: Unleash the Power of Inclusion" and been quoted in financial journals as well as The New York Times, Wall Street Journal and Forbes.com.

Dune attended Harvard Business School where she received an MBA and was the recipient of a Summer Social Enterprise Fellowship in 2003. She holds a BA from Dartmouth College in Economics where she was captain of the nationally ranked Women's Lacrosse team and received All-Ivy Academic Honors. She is a graduate of the Boston Center for Community & Justice Lead Boston Program, the Global Leadership and Public Policy for the 21st Century at the Harvard Kennedy School and the Leadership in Energy Innovation and Environmental Consideration at Princeton University.

Ms. Thorne has three children and her personal passions are the arts, running, skiing, golf, tennis, traveling, being outside and active with her family and doing everything she can to help build a more equitable and just society.

Trailblazer Award



ADRIENNE WARREN

Adrienne Warren's talent as a singer, actress, and dancer has established her as a dynamic triple threat.

Warren is perhaps most well known for her Tony Award-winning performance as Tina Turner in Broadway's *Tina: The Tina Turner Musical*. Warren originated the role in numerous workshops of the show, working together with Tina Turner herself to embody the titular role. Warren transferred the role to Broadway following the 2018 West End production, for which she earned 2019 Olivier, Evening Standard, and Joe Allen Award nominations.

Warren's performance in the Broadway run has been heralded as "extraordinary" (*The Hollywood Reporter*), "electrifying" (*Rolling Stone*) and "star-making" (*The New York Times*). In addition to the Tony Award, she also received a Chita Rivera nomination and the Drama Desk, Antonyo, and Outer Critics Circle Awards for her iconic performance.

Warren previously earned Tony and Chita Rivera Award nominations for her performance as Gertrude Saunders/Florence Mills in the Broadway production

of *Shuffle Along* opposite Audra McDonald. Warren made her Broadway debut in 2012's *Bring It On: The Musical* and previously appeared onstage in *The Wiz* (Encores! City Center) and *Dreamgirls* (The Apollo; NAACP Theatre Award nomination).


She made her Carnegie Hall debut in 2017 with the New York Pops and continues to perform around the world. In 2023, she was featured on PBS's annual "A Capitol Fourth" performing an electrifying tribute to the late Tina Turner.

Warren can currently be seen in the highly anticipated feature film, *Rustin*, starring Coleman Domingo, and *The Woman King*, starring Viola Davis. She starred as Benny in Hulu's *Black Cake*, based on the best-selling book. Warren will star and serve as executive producer on the new Peacock series *Dreamland*.

Warren starred as Mamie Till-Mobley, who devoted her life to seeking justice for her son Emmett Till, in *Women of the Movement*, a limited series for ABC. Other television and film credits include *Paws & Fury: The Legend of Hank, Helpsters, Quantico, Black Box, Blue Bloods*, and *Orange is the New Black*. Warren's voice can also be heard as the iconic spokesperson for Maybelline Cosmetics.

Warren is a co-founder of the Broadway Advocacy Coalition (BAC), which unites artists, experts, students, and community leaders to use storytelling and artistry to combat systemic racism. BAC received a special Tony Award in 2021.

She is a graduate of Marymount Manhattan College and the Governor's School for the Arts in Norfolk, Virginia.


